Application and Enrollment Fees are as follows:

- \$75 application/testing fee for *new* students
- \$300 enrollment fee for *new* students
- Current students registering *after* the re-enrollment period has ended must submit a \$300 re-enrollment fee and enter the waiting pool.

***Monthly Payment Plan via FACTS Financial:** Eleven (11) monthly payments are deducted via FACTS for the months July 2022 through May 2023. (Total tuition less \$350 deposit divided by 11 months). Payment plans will be prorated for families that enroll after the first tuition draft in July.

****Annual Tuition Payment via FACTS Financial:** Annual tuition is reduced by 2% for a single payment made by July 5, 2022 via FACTS Financial. Annual payments not received by July 5, 2022 will be converted automatically to monthly payment accounts.

Tuition Payment Information

Annual tuition payment is due via FACTS Financial on or before July 5, 2022. Monthly tuition payments begin on July 25, 2022 and end on May 25, 2023 through FACTS Financial. Annual payments not received by July 5th will revert to monthly drafts.

Enrollment Information

The re-enrollment period is January 7, 2022 through January 28, 2022. After January 28th, all re-enrollment contracts must go through the application process as a newcomer, pay the \$300 enrollment fee, and enter the waiting pool.

Discounts

First Baptist Church Members receive a 10% annual tuition credit (full-time students in Young 3s through 8th grade).

Families with more than two children will be granted a multi-child discount at the rate of 10% reduction of tuition beginning with the third child, provided that all children are full-time students.

Tuition Refund Plan

Your financial obligation to the school is for the full annual tuition as stated in our enrollment contract. FBCS cannot refund tuition or cancel unpaid obligations if a student is forced to withdraw during the academic year. If your student withdraws, the Tuition Refund Plan will pay benefits ranging from 60% - 100% (subject to the terms of the policy and the amount insured) to the school, which provides substantial assistance in meeting your financial obligation. Every year, thousands of students must withdraw from private schools. The following are examples of reasons why: family move, change of objective, injury or sickness, death of parent or student, disciplinary dismissal, scholastic difficulties, financial problems, mental health conditions, or job loss.

The Plan provides substantial protection at 2.5% of your tuition obligation per child.

What the Plan covers:

Withdrawal or absence for medical reasons

- The Plan will pay 100% of the unused yearly insured fees, provided the student's injury or sickness forces the student to withdraw from school or medical absence lasts for 31 or more consecutive calendar days (including weekends and holidays). Benefits are paid retroactive to the first day of medical absence.
- The Plan will pay 60% of the unused yearly insured fees, provided the student's mental health condition, as referenced in DSM V, forces the student to withdraw from school or medical absence lasts for 31 or more consecutive calendar days (including weekends and holidays). Benefits are paid retroactive to the first day of medical absence.

Withdrawal for other than medical reasons

(Examples include: moves, change of objective, financial hardship and voluntary withdrawals.)

- The Plan will pay 60% of the unused yearly insured fees provided the student has withdrawn from school after attending more than fourteen consecutive calendar days (including weekends and holidays) beginning with the student's first class day of attendance in the academic year.

Dismissal from the school

- The Plan will pay 75% of the unused yearly insured fees provided the student is dismissed from the school after attending more than fourteen consecutive calendar days (including weekends and holidays) beginning with the student's first class day of attendance in the academic year.
